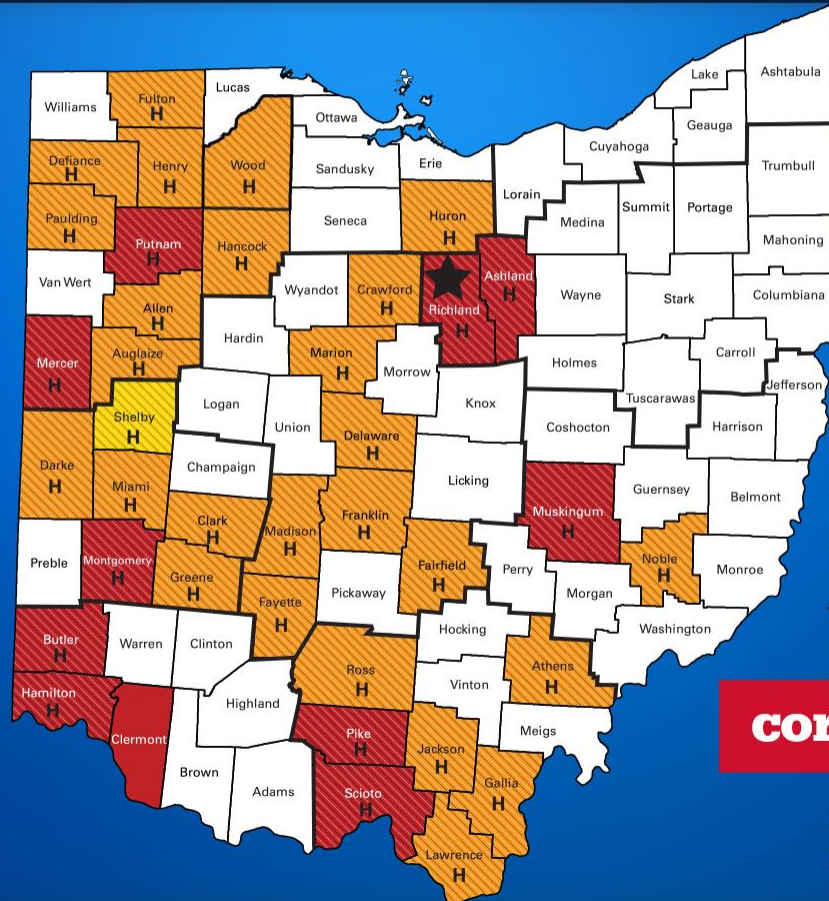

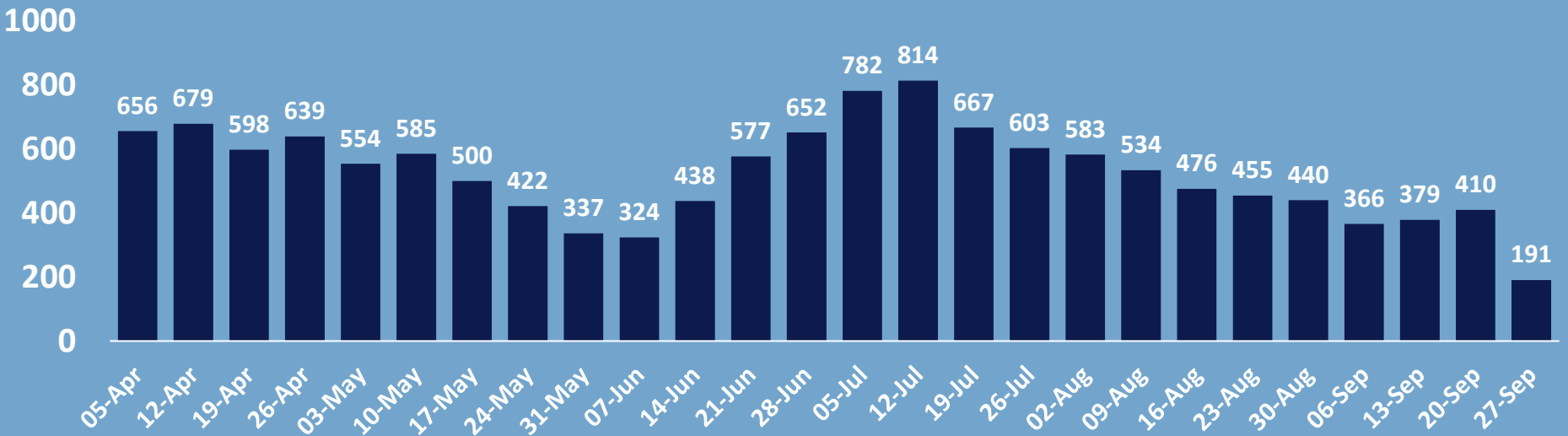

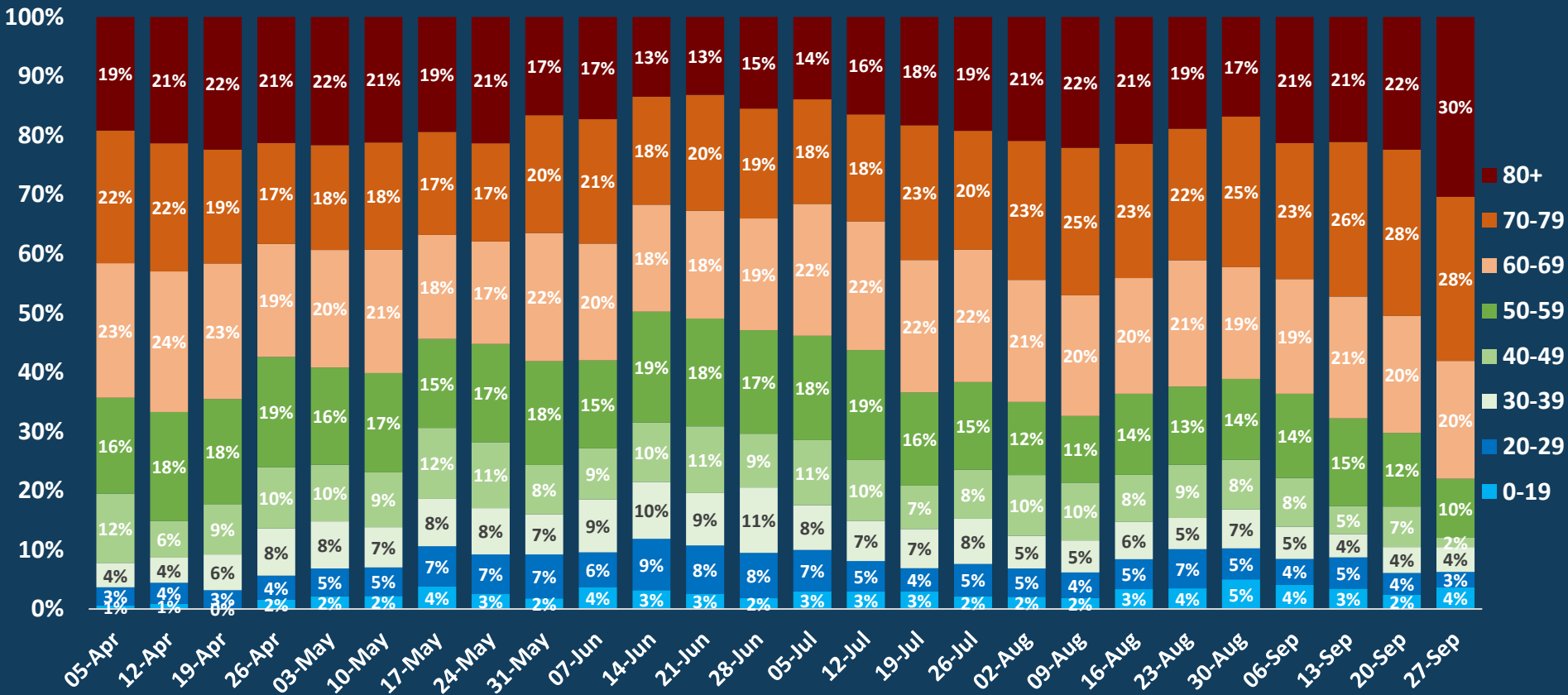

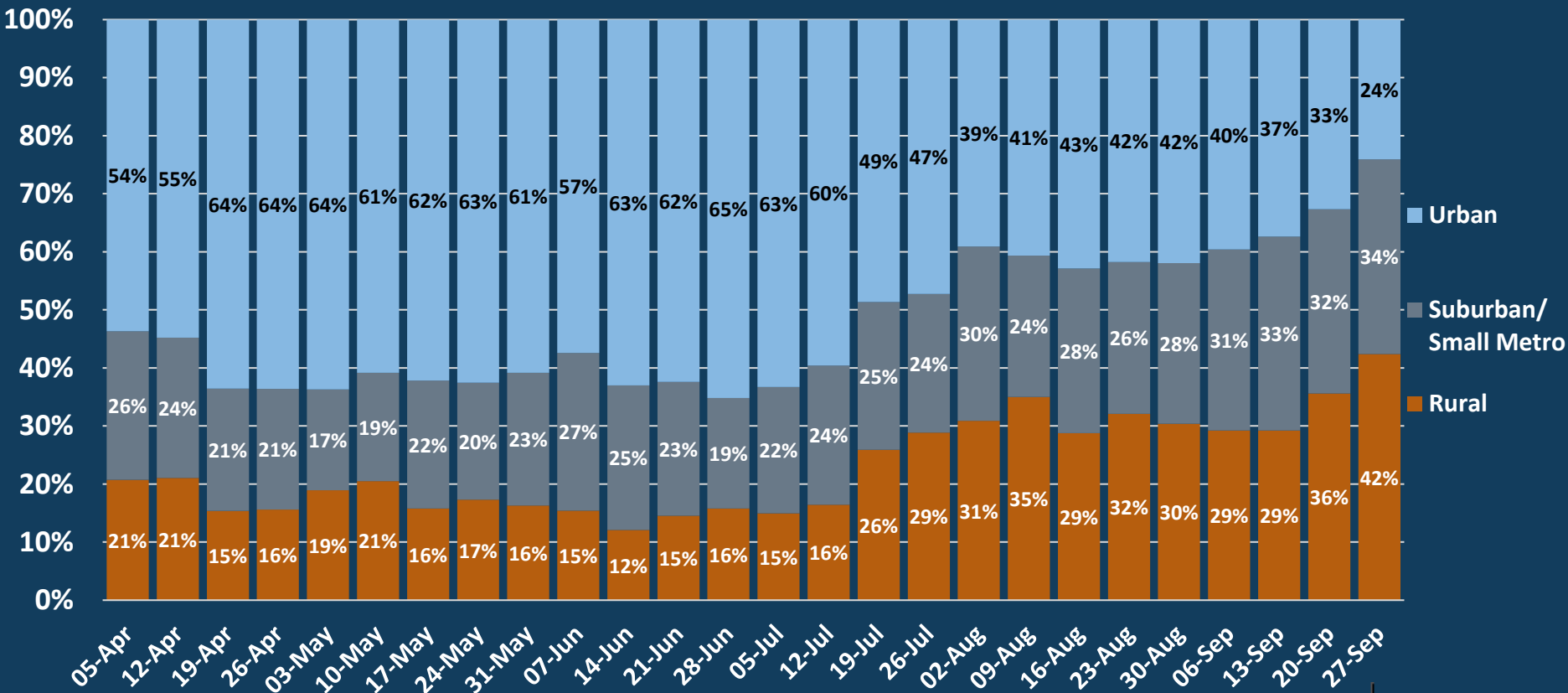
# COVID-19 | Number of Weekly Hospital Admissions



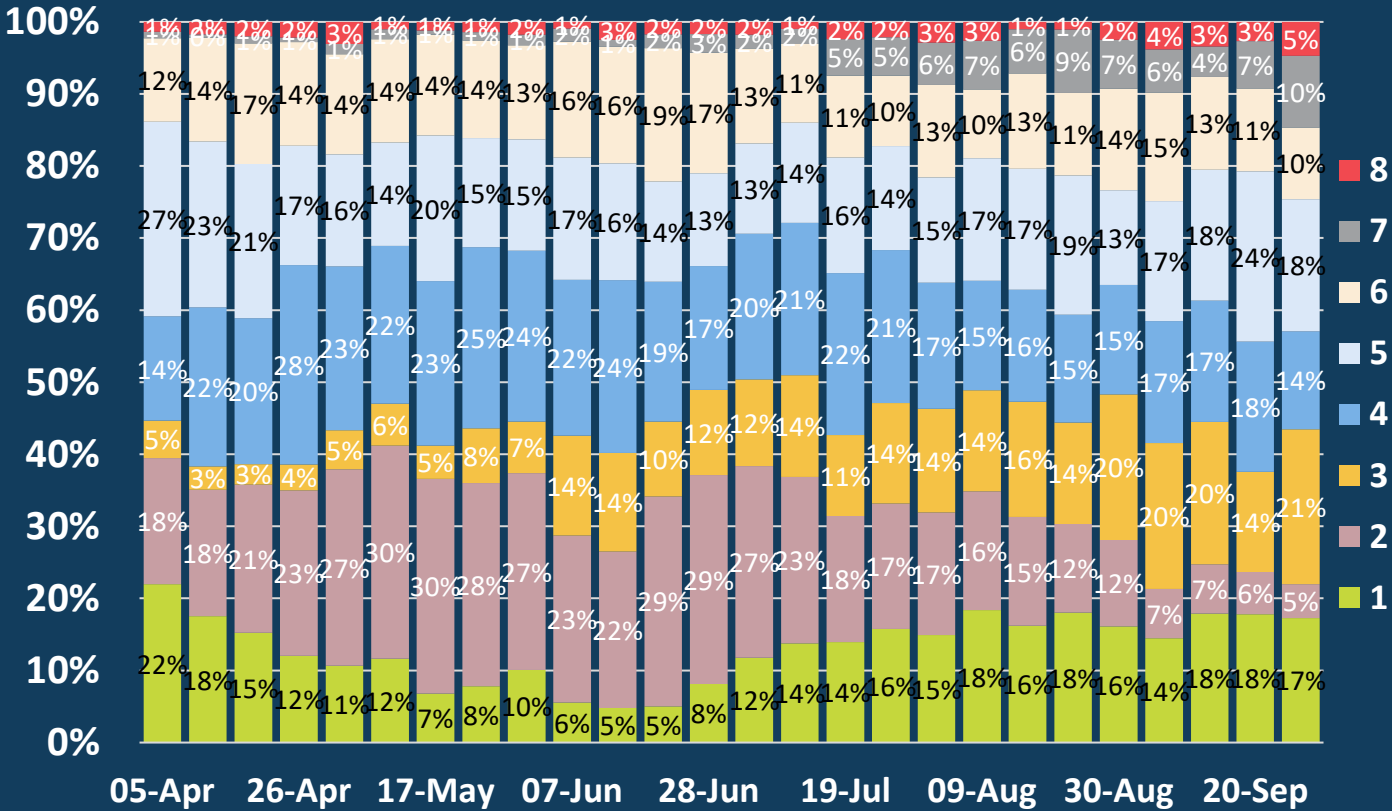
# COVID-19 | Hospital Admissions by Age



# COVID-19 | Hospital Admissions by County of Residence Type



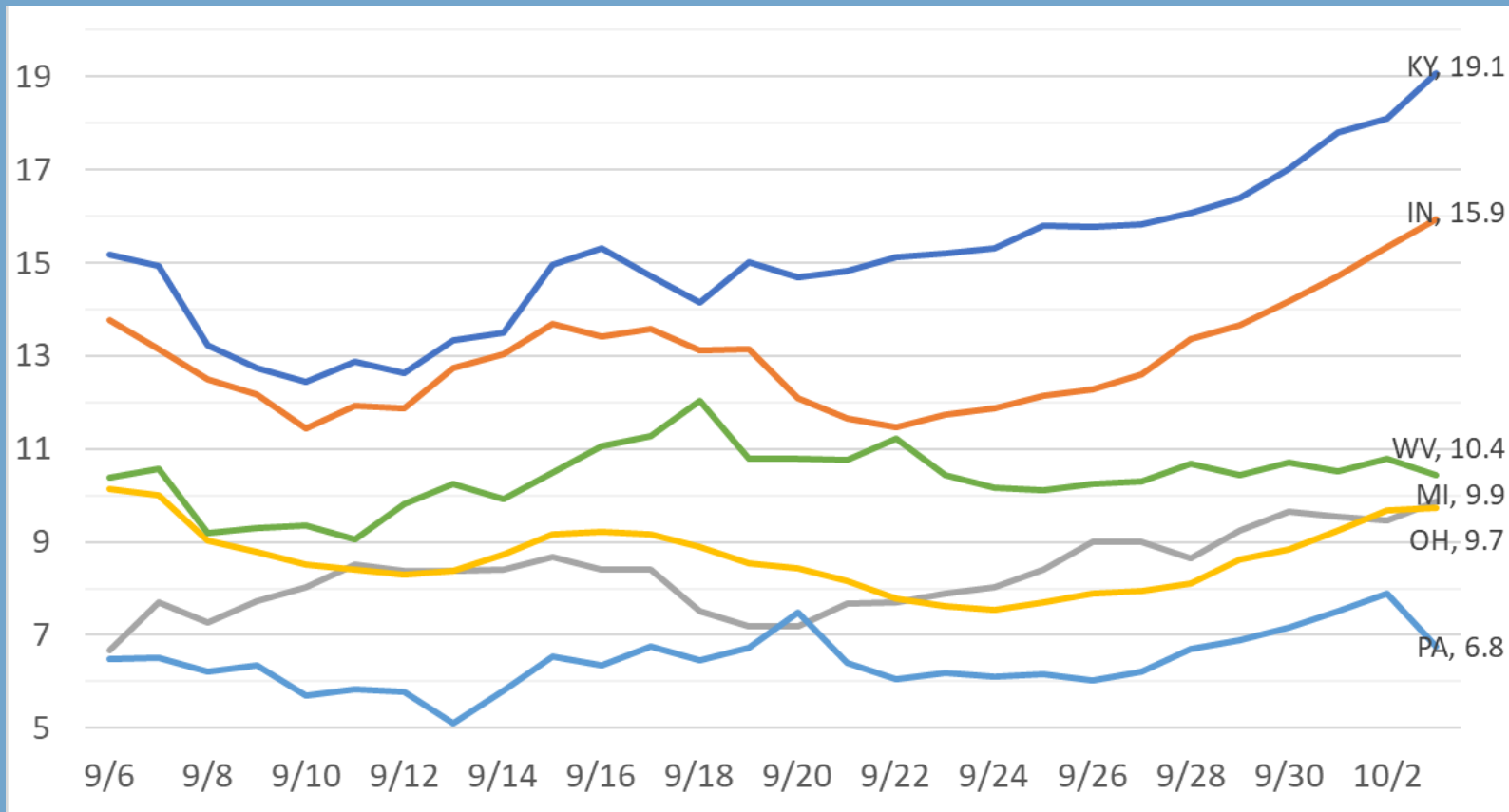
# COVID-19 | Percentage of Hospital Admissions by Region of Residence



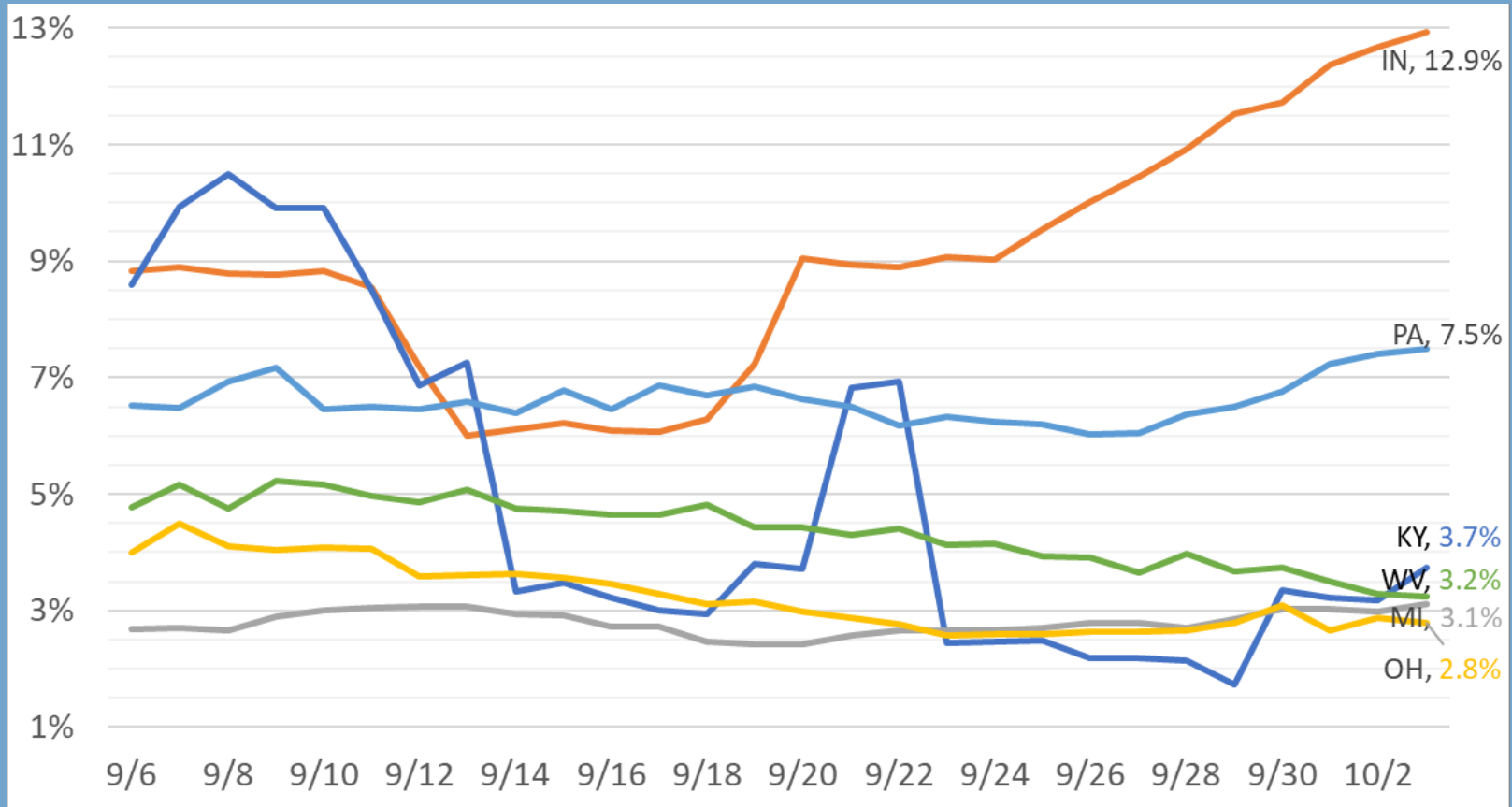

# Neighboring States, 28-Day Trends: Cases per 100,000 per Day, by State

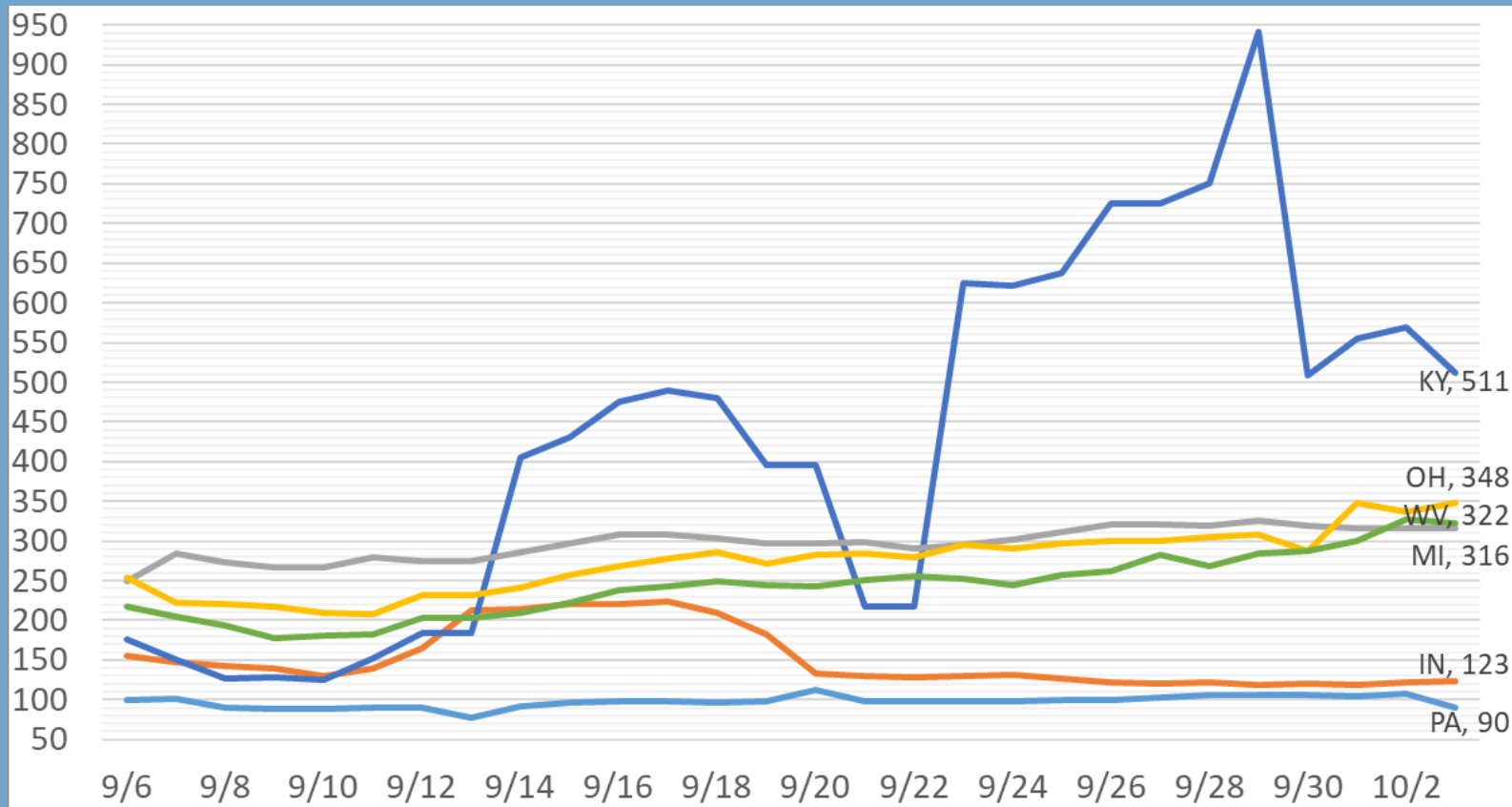


# Neighboring States, 28-Day Trends: Percent Positivity, by State





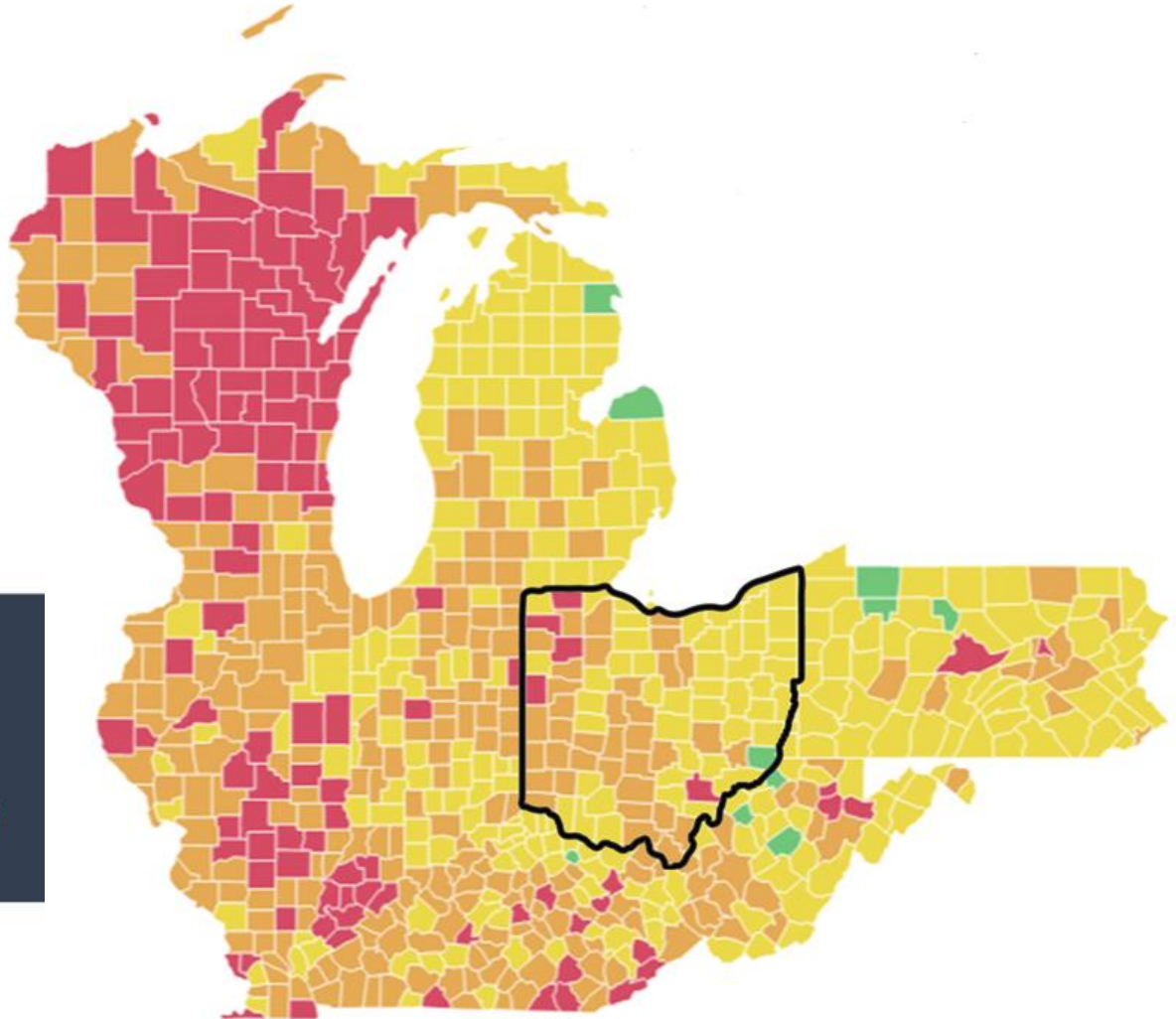

AKRON, Ohio – A 25-year-old man died and two other are in critical condition following a shooting and related vehicular crash at a bar in Akron's Middlebury neighborhood, according to police.

The victim's name has not been publicly released, pending family notifications, according to the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office.

Officers responded around 1:30 a.m. Friday to a shooting at The Corner Pocket Bar & Grill at 805 Upson Street, near North Arlington Street, according to a police report.
