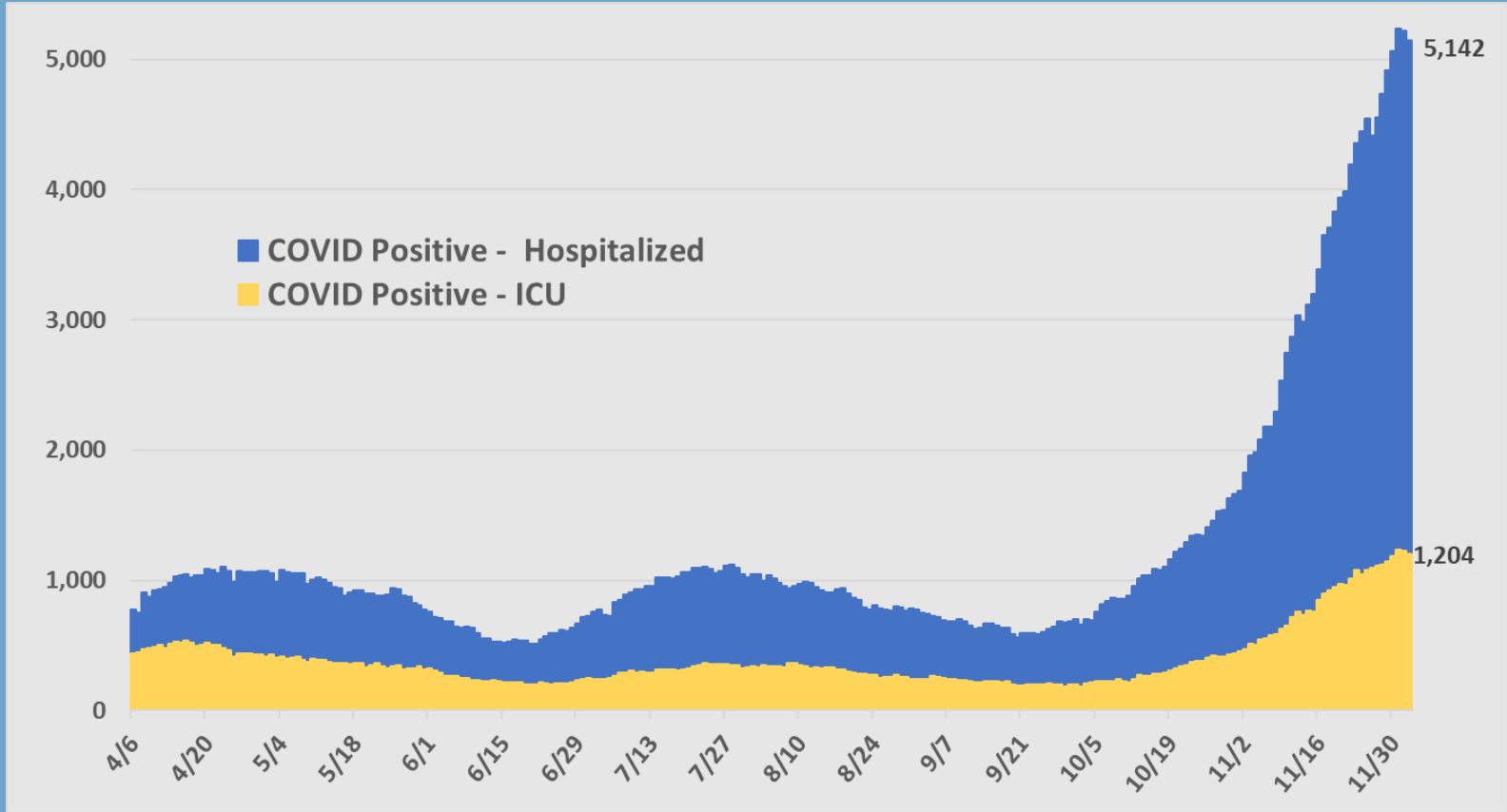


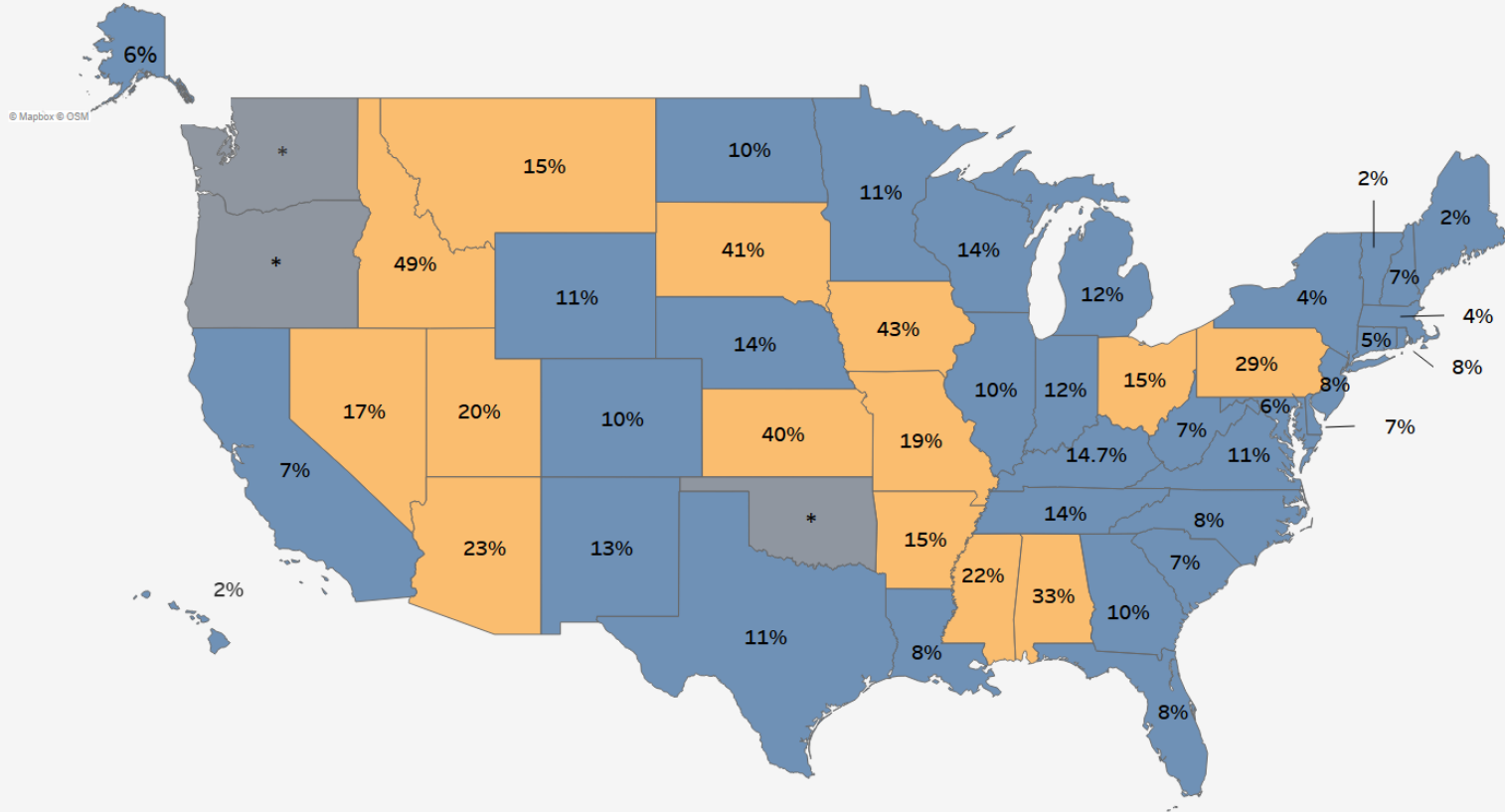
Current Confirmed COVID - 19 Patient Count in Ohio Hospitals by Day *

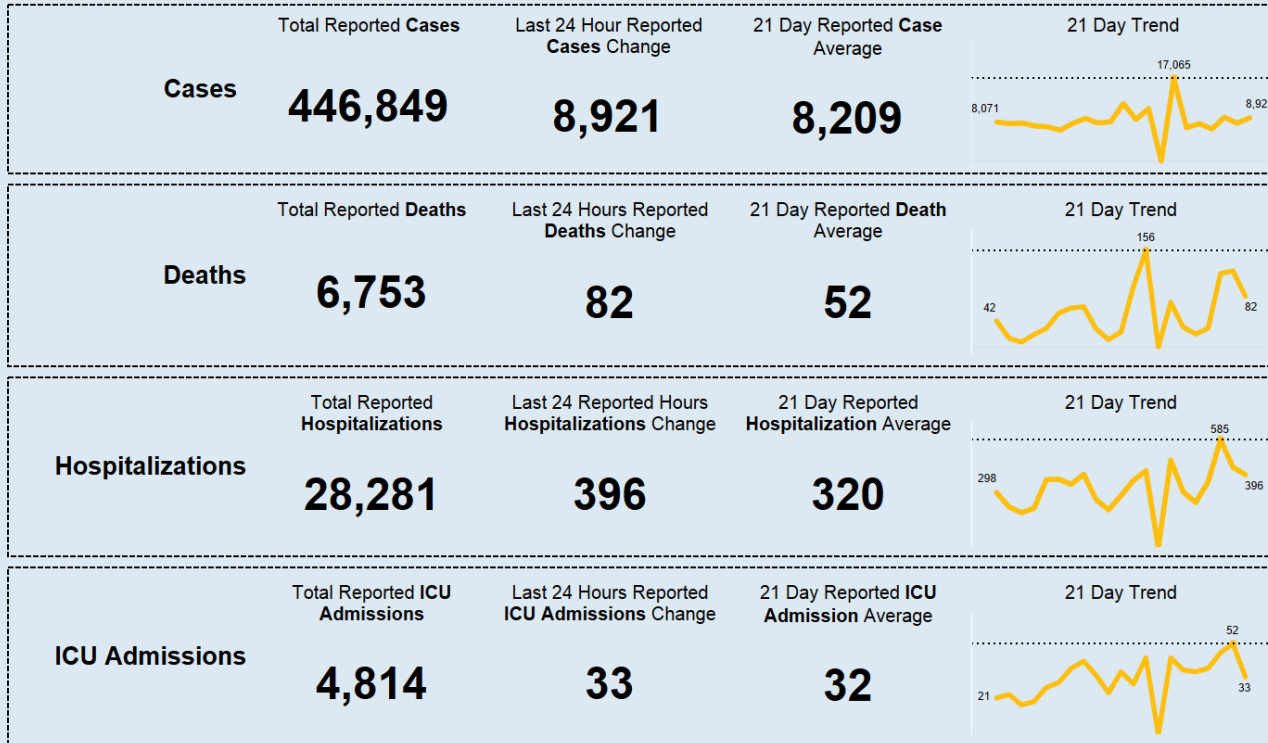
Travel Advisory Map

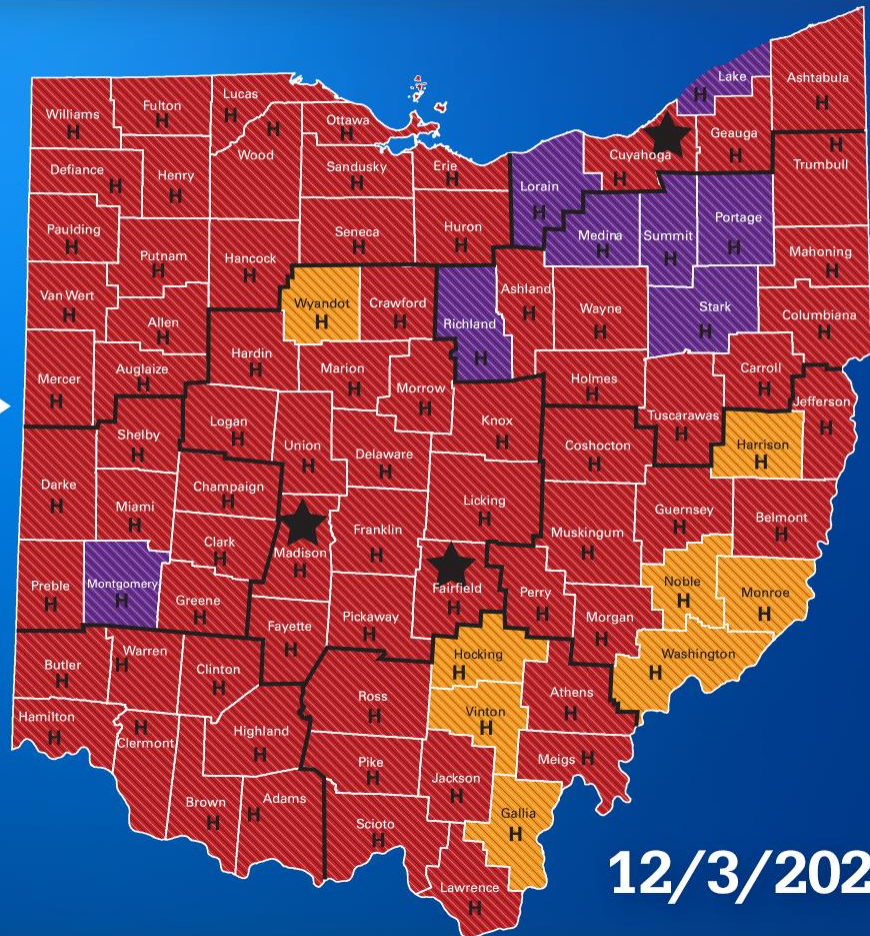
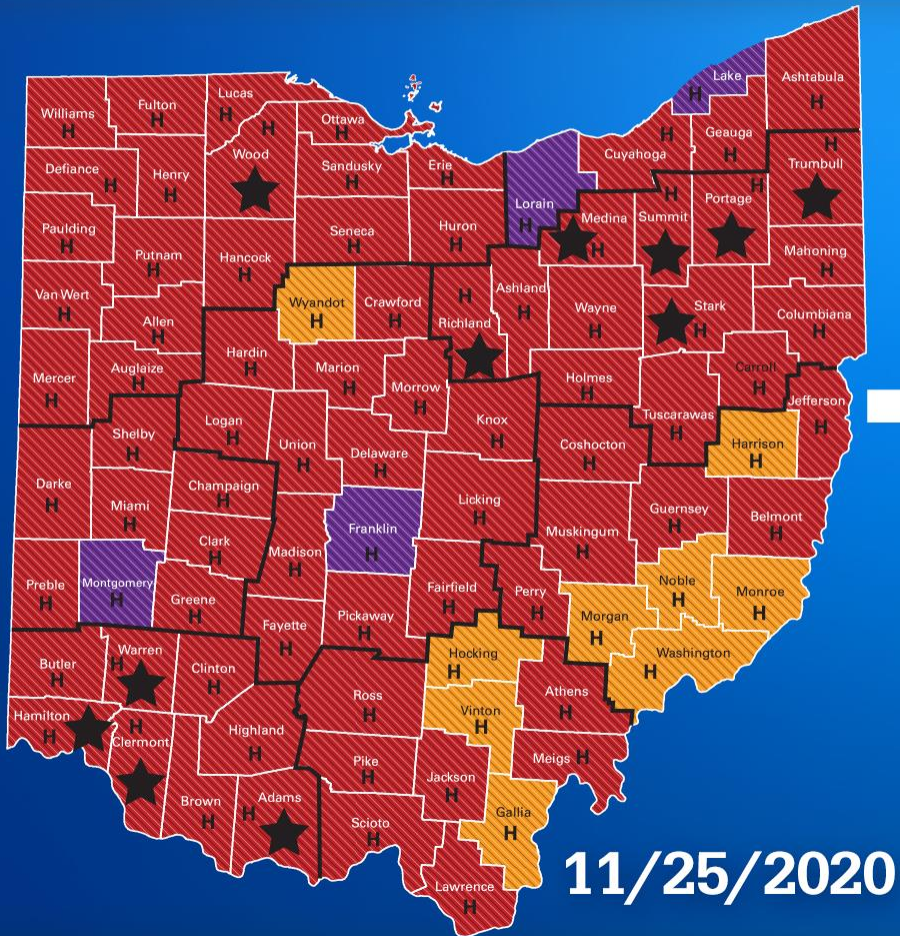

LEVEL 3

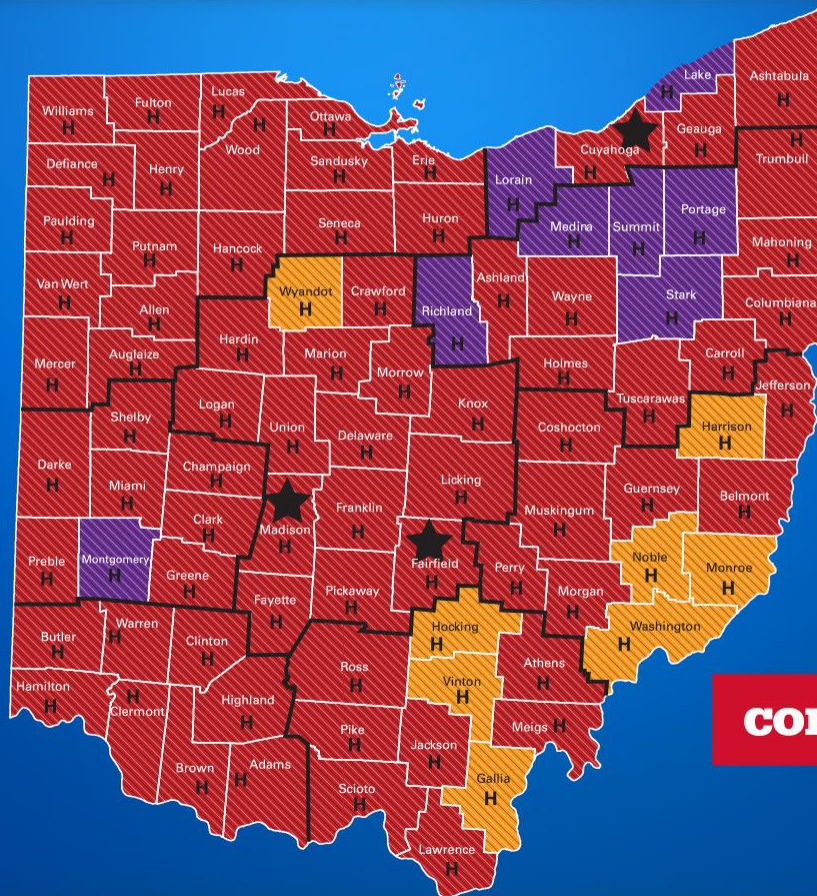
Public Emergency
