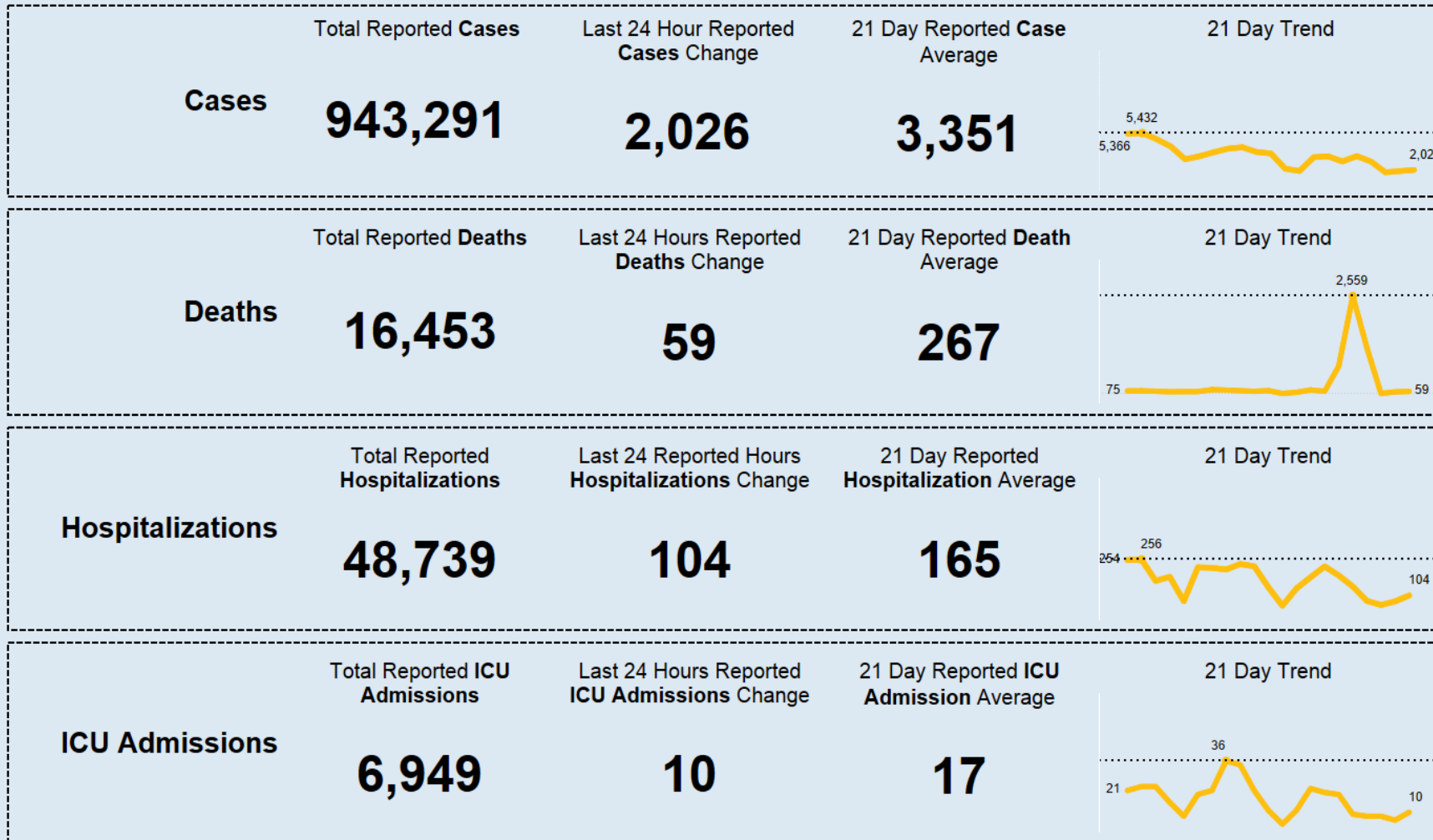


COVID - 19 | Key Indicators

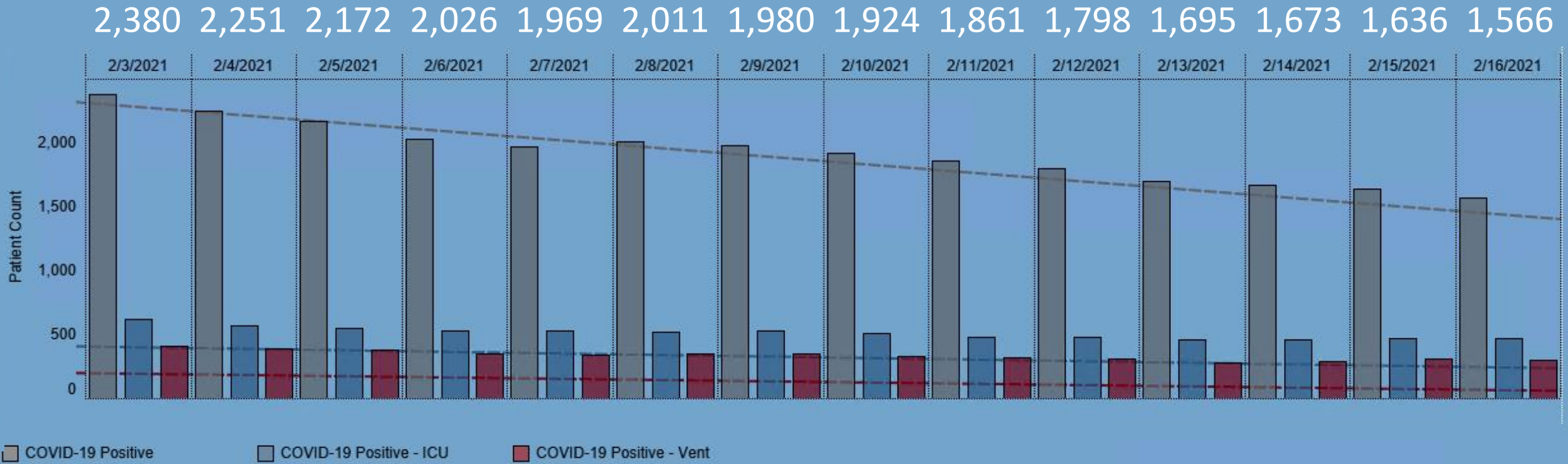
