Epicerie (pronounced ay/peehs/ree) et les fleurs is a new restaurant combined with the old Rosey Reds in Somerset. Terri Reichley and Larry Myres, a dynamic sister/ brother team, took the jump to expand on what they love to do... cooking with style! From the very beginning of opening the bistro, they committed to using washable dinnerware, real table clothes, also composting food waste in partnership with Fern Hollow Farm.

Takeout orders go in compostable containers made from plants. When asked about using compostable instead of Styrofoam clamshells, Larry said, "It's not much more cost and it's the right thing to do. 100 take-outs might cost \$10. It's definitely worth it. Customers appreciate it too." They also believe in giving back to the community. Each month they donate 10% of a day's sales to a local cause or organization.
