



### 2021 Impact

- Last year, with your help, we processed 44 donated hogs totaling over 5,000 pounds of sausage to help feed nearly 6,700 people in Perry County through the Fill the Freezer Campaign. Perry County food pantry's received the processed sausage from this campaign and served the following residents.

### 2022 Need

- Food pantries in Southeast Ohio have seen a 58% increase in foot traffic since the beginning of year due to inflation and other economic factors. But, no one goes hungry in Perry County. That is the goal of the Community Foundation for Perry County (CFPC) Hunger Fund. We need your help again this year to address food insecurity in the county.

### What you can do to help

- When buyers win the bid you will be asked “Keep, Turn or Donate” their purchased pigs. Answer **DONATE** it to the **Fill the Freezer Campaign**. It's that easy. The Community Foundation for Perry County Hunger Fund along with local meat processors have partnered to pay all processing costs. Local 4-H Members will assist with logistics and excess sausage will be stored at the SE Ohio Foodbank for ongoing distribution. Will you help us this year?
