Judge Luann Cooperrider was born and raised in Perry County, Ohio and began her legal career in private practice in Thornville in 1983 and continued there until 1991. In 1986, she became the first female lawyer to be an assistant prosecutor in Perry County and continued at that position until 1990. On February 12, 1991, she took office as the Perry County Probate—Juvenile Judge, the first female judge in Perry County.
